



## 2019 - 2020 Quick Tips

Below are some tips to help teachers register for the Read to Succeed Program:

- Go to [www.sixflags.com/read](http://www.sixflags.com/read)
- It will look like this:

- Enter your email address. Enter a password (twice). The password needs to include at least one upper case letter, one lowercase letter and one number. Then click on the green “Register” button.
- You will then go through the registration process. The next page you will see, will be this:

*Choose this option if you are registering students at a public or private school. Do NOT choose this option if you are registering home school students.*

## Teacher Ticket Rule

**APPLIES TO BOTH TRADITIONAL SCHOOLS AND HOME SCHOOLS**

In an effort to ensure the integrity and future viability of our Read to Succeed program we have adjusted the minimal qualifications required to receive a free adult teacher ticket. Beginning this year **only teachers (or qualified staff) who submit a minimum of eight (8) completed student reading logs will receive a free teacher ticket**. This new policy applies to both traditional schools and home schools.

All elementary school students (both at traditional schools and home schools) who participate in the program and who complete a minimum of six hours of reading will receive a free ticket to Six Flags, regardless of the size of their class or the number of student reading logs submitted. However, only teachers who submit at least eight reading logs will receive a free ticket.

I understand that only teachers who submit eight (8) or more eligible student logs will receive a free teacher ticket this year.

- You will also need to tell us what subjects you teach (ex. Reading, All Subjects, Language Arts, etc). Then you can click on the green “Continue” button on the bottom of the page.

Almost all of our communication with you, including ticket delivery, is via email. To ensure that you don't have any issues with your account we have a couple of different password recovery options.

Please provide us with an alternative (additional) email address. We will use it only if only for important updates, password resets and ticket deliveries.

If you provide an alternative email address we will only use it for RTS related business and we will never sell, rent it. The answers to these security questions are encrypted using commercial-grade BCrypt (Blowfish) hashing techniques and cannot be decrypted by anyone on our staff.

**School** is the Read To Succeed Coordinator for Vivian B. Majors Elementary School

When it is time to deliver the tickets, all of the tickets for Vivian B. Majors Elementary School will be emailed to the coordinator, and teachers that registered and completed the program. The tickets will also be available in the teachers' and coordinator's online account. The coordinator will reach out to you to let you know who will be responsible for printing the tickets out for your school. For the [redacted] volunteered to be the official coordinator for Vivian B. Majors Elementary School.

**What does this mean to you?** The fact that [redacted] our coordinator means several things you should be aware of:

- We have sent a note to [redacted] informing him/her that you have signed up for this year's Read to Succeed program.

**Introducing eReading Logs!**

In response to numerous requests from both teachers and parents alike, we're pleased to announce that we've upgraded the program so parents can now log their children's reading time directly into our site. We believe that this will make it easier than ever for you to participate in Read To Succeed.

**Here is how eReading Logs work:**

1. Print and distribute your personalized Reading Logs which include instructions, a registration link, and your personal Read to Succeed registration code.
2. Parents register their children online using your code. *You'll be able to view (and edit) a list of everyone who has registered.*
3. From November to February, parents log their child's reading, including which books were read and for how long. *You can view all of the logs and monitor your student's progress.*
4. In February, you'll review your student's logs. If they look OK you just click the "Approve" button. Then you're DONE.
5. In May, you can choose to hand out reading certificates yourself or let the parents download them directly.

That's it! We think this new program will make it easier than ever for your students to earn rewards through Read To Succeed!

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- You will see that you have 4 tabs across the top:

- The Your Profile tab will allow you to see your information and make any edits
- The Your Students tab is where your student information will appear
- The eReading Logs tab is where you will find your downloadable, personalized reading log that you will need to share with your student's parents
- The Teacher Toolbox tab is where you can view and download the program materials.

- While your registration is now complete, your work is not done.
- Send your students home with the personalized Reading log.
  - The personalized Reading Log will be available in your eReading Logs tab:

For the 2019-2020 school year we're replacing our regular reading logs with **eReading Logs**. Parents can now log their own child's reading, saving you time and making it easier than ever to promote at-home reading.

- Once parents begin logging their child's reading in the eReading Log, you will be able to view the student list in the "Your Students" tab. If you see any students in your list with zero hours, please be patient as the hours from the parent portal syncs with your student list. Only use the "EDIT" button once we are closer to the deadline to fix any typos on student names or grade level. Note, there is a "DEL" button – only use this to delete a student that is NOT in your class or if a student was accidentally added multiple times.

**Review and Approve Your Students**

You'll use this page to review and approve your students after their parents log their reading hours. In the spring you'll also be able to use it to enter students whose parents do not have access to a computer and who had to submit a paper reading log.

Frequently Asked Questions

- A student's name is listed twice in my certificate.
- What happens if my child forgets their name?

- If you have any student whose parents do not have access to a computer or smartphone, please have them use the personalized Reading Log to handwrite their reading time. They will need to turn in the log to you prior to the April 17<sup>th</sup> deadline. Once you have the handwritten log, then you can add the student and their total hours in your account. Teachers will have the Add Student function in their account in the Spring.
