PARK SAFETY/CODE OF CONDUCT RULES:
A complete listing of park rules are available at Guest Relations and sixflags.com

To ensure all guests have a fun, safe and memorable experience, please follow all Park Rules. Guests who break Park Rules may be asked to leave the Park without a refund. Thanks for doing your part to ensure that everyone has a great time while visiting!

- Please do not sit or stand on fences or railings.
- For your safety, diving and running are not permitted.
- Inflatables, swimmies and pool toys are not permitted.
- All guests are required to pass through metal detection and bag inspection prior to park entry.

Good Behavior: Guests are here to have a good time and are expected to behave in an appropriate family-friendly manner. Unruly, disruptive or offensive behavior, including line-jumping/holding places in line, use of profanity, abusive language or gestures will not be tolerated.

Dress Code: In keeping with our family-friendly environment, and for safety reasons, Six Flags enforces a dress code. Clothing, swimwear or tattoos with offensive language or graphics are not permitted at any time. Examples of clothing or swimwear not permitted are those displaying: profanity, pornography, graphic violence, support of drugs and drug use, gang symbols and the promotion of discrimination against any group. Proper swimwear is required for a family-friendly environment and to participate on the attractions. Thong swimsuits and swimwear with buttons, zippers, rivets or snaps on the back or sides are not permitted. Jeans, cut-off jeans or shorts will not be permitted. Footwear is suggested to protect your feet from hot pavement. Park admission may be denied if clothing, swimwear or tattoos are deemed to be inappropriate by management and the Guest refuses all reasonable options. Shirts cannot be turned inside out as a solution.

Shoes/Aqua Socks/T-Shirts: Are not permitted on body slides and other select attractions.

Diaper Dependent Guests: For health and sanitary reasons, diaper dependent guests must wear watherproof swim diapers (available at Island Traders) before entering water attraction. Infants may only be changed on changing stations, not on lounge chairs or tables. Anyone who has experienced a stomach and/or intestinal illness within the past two weeks may not participate in any water attractions.

Hygiene: Please shower before entering swimming locations. Good hygiene is important for safe, clean water. Showers are located in the Island Village.

Line Jumping: Line jumping is strictly prohibited. Guests are not permitted to save places in line.

No Smoking: Smoking, including electronic cigarettes (e-cigarettes), is permitted only in areas identified as Designated Smoking Areas. No cannabis or derived products are allowed to be possessed, smoked or consumed on property.

Restrictions: Outside food, beverages, alcoholic beverages, coolers and pets (other than service animals) are not allowed. All guests enter through metal detection and inspection areas. Items that are not permitted in the Park must be returned to your vehicle. No loose articles such as cameras and cell phones are

allowed on select rides. Guests are not permitted in restricted areas, which include ride and backstage areas.

Park Re-Entry: Guests who wish to return to the park on the same day must have their original entry ticket re-scanned.

Photography: By entering the Park, guests grant Six Flags the right to film, video, record and photograph guest on Park property and use such footage or photography for any reason without payment or consideration. All Six Flags rides, shows and attractions are protected by copyright. Guests must have written permission to use photographs and/or videotape of Six Flags images for commercial broadcasting, advertising, marketing or publishing in any medium. Filming on rides with a GoPro or similar equipment is not permitted.

Purchase of Alcohol: A state-issued ID is required for all alcohol purchases. Only one drink per person will be sold at a time. Alcoholic drinks are not permitted in ride stations or queue lines.

Selfie Sticks, Monopods & Similar Devices: Selfie sticks, monopods and similar devices are not allowed inside Six Flags parks. Guests who bring selfie sticks to the park will be asked to store them in their cars during their visit.
