



# SAFETY & ACCESSIBILITY GUIDE

FOR MORE INFORMATION PLEASE VISIT GUEST RELATIONS

## **INTRODUCTION:**

We are thrilled you have chosen to spend your day at Six Flags! Our goal is to make your visit fun and memorable. This Six Flags Guest Safety and Accessibility Guide includes important information to assist Guests with planning their visit to the park and enjoy its various attractions, rides, services and amenities. In this Guide, Guests will find specific information for individuals with disabilities along with general policies and guidelines.

We work closely with the manufacturer of each of our rides and our policies incorporate the manufacturers' guidelines as well as the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. We hope that this Guide will help Guests make the best choices to ensure a safe, comfortable and convenient experience at the park. If, at any time, Guests need additional assistance or a further explanation of our policies and guidelines, they should feel free to ask any Six Flags Team Member.

Our goal is to safely and efficiently accommodate the needs of all Guests, including individuals with disabilities. This Guide, along with the availability of our Team Members to answer any questions and offer assistance, will allow Guests to have a thrilling and safe day at the park.

## **GENERAL WARNING:**

We are committed to providing you a safe environment during your visit to Six Flags. While there are inherent risks to participating in any amusement park ride or attraction, our goal is to ensure your safety with the incorporation of some restrictions. For your safety, you should be in good health to ride. Only you know your physical conditions or limitations.

Many amusement park rides incorporate safety systems designed by the manufacturer to accommodate people of average physical stature and body proportion. These safety systems may place restrictions on the ability of a Guest to safely be contained within the ride restraint. Guests who have heart, back or neck trouble or conditions, pregnant women, people who have had recent surgery or an illness, people with casts, braces, restrictive devices, larger or smaller body shapes or certain disabilities may not be safely accommodated by certain ride systems. For example, height requirements are based on the size needed for safety restraints to function properly and the level of maturity usually associated with a certain height.

If you suspect your health could be at risk for any reason, or you could aggravate a pre-existing condition of any kind, **DO NOT RIDE**. The specific

features, rider requirements and health restrictions of each ride are described later in this Guide.

In order to ride, all Guests must be able to maintain the proper riding position, meet the ride requirements and appropriately utilize the restraint systems, including lap bars, shoulder harnesses and seatbelts as indicated. All Guests must also be able to demonstrate a willingness and ability to comply with verbal and written rider requirements.

Six Flags reserves the right to make the final determination regarding eligibility of a Guest to ride a particular ride based on the Guest's size, weight, height or other limitations. Information in this Guide is subject to change.

## **RIDER RESPONSIBILITY:**

All Guests have a duty to exercise good judgment and act in a responsible manner while participating on a ride or attraction and to obey all verbal and written warnings and instructions. Guests also have a duty to properly use all ride and attraction safety equipment provided.

## **PARKING:**

Accessible parking is available on a first-come, first-serve basis within the main parking lots of the park. When you arrive at the parking toll booths, ask a Team Member for instructions regarding where to proceed to the accessible parking lot. Both auto and van accessible spaces are provided. A valid disabled persons parking placard or license plate must be displayed at all times while parked in the designated accessible parking area. If the designated accessible parking area is full at the time of your arrival, members of your party may be dropped off at the main pick-up/drop-off area, near the main entrance to the park. Please ask a Team Member for directions to additional parking areas.

## **WHEELCHAIRS AND ELECTRIC CONVENIENCE VEHICLES (ECV'S):**

Wheelchairs and electric convenience vehicles (ECV's) are available for rent at Main Street Service Center. A deposit is also required.

Guests may also use their own wheelchairs or ECV's. If you need to take the rented wheelchair or ECV outside of the park, a Team Member escort is necessary to do so. Please ask for assistance at Guest Relations. Battery recharging is also available at Guest Relations.

Guests using wheelchairs or ECV's may utilize any ticket window and designated turnstiles to enter the park. Many of the park's shopping and dining facilities are also wheelchair accessible. Many of the rides and attractions have queues that are accessible to Guests using manual wheelchairs. If an alternate entrance is required, these entrances are generally at the ride exit and are identified by a sign with the universal wheelchair symbol. Please keep in mind that there are specific boarding requirements and accommodations for those using wheelchairs at each ride or attraction.

## **SEGWAY:**

Due to varying walkways, terrains and large crowds, we cannot permit the use of two-wheeled, self-balancing electric vehicles such as Segways. We are pleased to offer other forms of transportation, including ECV's and standard wheelchairs. Please contact Guest Relations for more information.

## **SERVICE ANIMALS:**

Trained service animals are welcome at our Six Flags Theme Parks. Service animals are defined as dogs or miniature horses which are individually trained to do work or perform tasks for people with disabilities. Examples of such work or tasks include guiding people who are blind, alerting people who are deaf, pulling a wheelchair, alerting and protecting a person who is having a seizure, reminding a person with mental illness to take prescribed medications, calming a person with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) during an anxiety attack, or performing other duties. Service animals are working animals, not pets. The work or task a dog has been trained to provide must be directly related to the person's disability. Dogs whose sole function is to provide comfort or emotional support do not qualify as service animals. Miniature horses that have been individually

trained to do or perform tasks for people with disabilities will qualify as service animals.

Service animals must be house broken and remain on a leash or harness and under the control of their handler at all times. Guests whose service animal demonstrates aggressive and/or annoying actions toward a Guest or Team Member will be directed to remove the animal from the park.

Service animals are welcome in most locations of the park. Most of our rides are not equipped or designed for accessibility to service animals. Therefore, a member of your party must be available to stay with the animal while you ride.

### **Rides:**

Service animals, excluding miniature horses, are permitted on Capital Railways and the Carousel permitting they ride on a bench seat.

### **Haunted Mazes:**

Guests with service animals, please note that these attraction uses loud noises, theatrical lighting, special effects, and sudden moments intended to provide our guests with a thrilling experience. We rely on you to determine whether this attraction is appropriate for your service animal to experience. We remind guests with service animals that they must maintain full control of their service animal at all times while in the Park.

Guests may take advantage of our Kid Swap policy for staying with their service animal. However, park Team Members will not take responsibility for, or provide care to any service animal. Refer to the section on Kid Swap for more information.

A Service Animal "Relief Area" is located in the grassy areas next to Pirate's Flight. Owners are responsible for disposing of their animal's waste. Please look for this designated sign:



Please visit Guest Relations if you require additional information.

## RESTROOMS:

Most restrooms within the park are accessible for Guests using wheelchairs. Please check the park map for locations. The park's Team Members or Guest Relations can provide location directions should you need companion restrooms during your visit.

## ALTERNATE ACCESS:

Most of the park's theaters, attractions, restaurants and shops are accessible to wheelchairs. Most, if not all rides require transfer from the wheelchair to the ride seat. Special access entrances are available to accommodate Guests with mobility aides and service animals. These special entrances are generally at the ride exit and are identified by a sign with the universal wheelchair symbol. Entry, Exit and Transfer must be accomplished independently by the Guest or with the assistance of a member from his/her party. Six Flags Team Members are not trained in lifting or carrying persons with disabilities and are therefore not permitted to assist Guests on or off the rides. Not all rides have alternate access. If in doubt, please contact the Ride Attendant, The Rides Information Center, or Guest Relations for more information.

## ATTRACTION ACCESSIBILITY PROGRAM:

Our goal is to safely accommodate the needs of all Guests. Our policies comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and applicable state laws.

Six Flags' Attraction Accessibility Program is designed to accommodate guests with disabilities or certain other qualifying impairments so they may participate in the enjoyment of our Parks. Each attraction at Six Flags has been evaluated for the criteria necessary for an individual to ride safely. Our ridership criteria (set forth on page 8 of this Guide) is based on the requirements of the attraction manufacturer and the ability of guests to utilize all safety restraints and devices as designed, while maintaining the proper riding position throughout the duration of the ride. It is our policy to allow anyone to ride who meets all of these requirements and does not cause or create a legitimate safety concern to herself/himself or others. Our Attraction Accessibility Program matches the individual abilities of our guests to the ridership criteria for each attraction.

The Attraction Accessibility Program is an accommodation designed to provide equal access to Park attractions and not to bypass other guests waiting in the standard queue.

## The following procedures apply to guests who wish to participate in our Attraction Accessibility Program:

1. Guests can visit our Guest Relations Office to obtain Six Flags' Safety & Accessibility Guide to review the rider requirements of each ride or attraction. This Guide is also available on our website at [www.sixflags.com/America](http://www.sixflags.com/America).
2. To obtain an Attraction Access Pass guests with disabilities, mobility impairments or certain other qualifying impairments should visit the Guest Relations Office inside the Park.
  - a. Guests with cognitive disorders, disabilities or mobility impairments requesting additional accommodations must obtain the IBCCES Individual Accessibility Card (IAC) by registering at [www.accessibilitycard.org](http://www.accessibilitycard.org). The registration process requires information to be uploaded into a secure online portal. Once a Guest has filled out the online application and uploaded necessary documentation, they will be able to access their digital Accessibility Card. Guests will present the IBCCES Accessibility Card and Information Sheet to Guest Relations to receive any necessary accommodations.

**Note: Only IBCCES can issue an IBCCES Accessibility Card, and not Six Flags.**
3. In an effort to provide equal treatment to all of our guests, only those guests with a disability or other qualifying impairment and up to three (3) riding companions will be allowed to access attractions through the alternate entrance. If the guest's party is larger than four (4) guests, the other members of the party will be required to enter the attraction through the standard queue.
4. To use the Attraction Access Pass, the Guest whose name is listed on the pass will proceed to the attraction's alternate entrance and show the attraction attendant the Attraction Access Pass. The attraction attendant will document a reservation time that is comparable to the current wait time for the same ride/attraction. The guest, and up to three (3) riding companions, can then return to the attraction, using the alternate entrance, at the time of the reservation in order to ride.

A guest using an Attraction Access Pass may rest in a comfortable location or enjoy other attractions in the area until the assigned reservation time has come or when the others from the guest's party waiting in the standard queue reach the boarding platform. There is a 15 minute grace period for late arrivals.

A guest with an Attraction Access Pass must ride in order for the guest's companions to utilize the Attraction Access Pass to enter the attraction through the alternate entrance. If the guest with an Attraction Access Pass chooses not to ride, the guest's companions must wait in the standard queue.

Attraction Access Passes are not designed to bypass or "skip" the standard queue and the wait will be equal to the posted wait times. Individuals found to be fraudulently using the Attraction Access Pass will be in violation of our Guest Code of Conduct and may be subject to civil penalties. Violators may also be asked to leave the Park without any refund.

### IBCCES AND IBCCES ACCESSIBILITY CARD (IAC):



### Necessary Documentation/Information for Registration includes:

**Contact Information:** Name, email, address and phone/cell number

### Cardholder Information:

- Recent photo of the cardholder for identification purposes
- Birth date
- Name of the disability/disorder
- Helpful accommodations needed
- Name of the attraction you are visiting

### Healthcare Information

- Statement from a healthcare provider or Individualized Education Plan (IEP or equivalent) including the following:
  - Full name of the healthcare professional or education professional or NPI number (Provider ID) \*
  - Their title
  - Their phone number
  - Their email address
  - Statement indicating the guest has a disability or other qualifying impairment under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and/or applicable state law that prevents the guest from waiting in a standard queue. Please note that the nature of the disability does not have to be provided in the statement. If the disability is of a temporary nature, the doctor's note should state the time period of the temporary disability.

Not required if uploading an Individualized Education Plan. Individuals requesting the IAC must be 18 years or older.

*The IAC does NOT guarantee entry to the attraction and any special accommodations provided are at the sole discretion of the attraction.*

### PERSONAL CARE ATTENDANT:

**Personal Care Attendant-** The Personal Care Attendant (PCA) program is designed to accommodate guests with disabilities who are in need of support services such as personal hygiene, eating, toileting, transferring, safe movement, maintaining continence and/or medication management, in order to participate in the Park's goods, services and attractions. The PCA's attendance is required to enable the guest to participate in the Park's goods, services and attractions. The PCA is not a guest and shall not participate in any of the Park's good, services or attractions separate and apart from their client. The PCA receives compensation for the PCA's services, and the PCA is professionally licensed as a home health aide. If the Park discovers that the guest or the PCA has misrepresented the purpose of the PCA or that the PCA has acted as a patron of the Park as opposed to a PCA, the PCA and the guest will be expelled from the Park and may be barred from future entry.

## MEDICAL DEVICES AND MOBILITY AIDES:

For your safety and the safety of others, riders may be required to remove medical devices, half or full length orthotics, braces, crutches, canes, prosthetics and any other type of medical assistance device that is not permanently affixed to the rider's body to prevent hazards or loss due to ride forces. These devices prevent safety restraints from working as designed, keep the rider from maintaining the proper riding posture, and present a hazard to the rider or others. If in doubt about your ability to safely experience a ride or attraction, please refer to the Rider Requirement Sign at the ride entrance. You may also consult with a Ride Attendant or Guest Relations for more information.

Please also refer to the "Ride Information" section of this Guide for specific information regarding removal of medical devices and mobility aides on a ride by ride basis. If you have any questions, please ask a Ride Attendant or visit Guest Relations.

## LARGER FRAMED GUESTS:

Many rides incorporate safety systems designed by the manufacturer to accommodate people of average physical stature and body proportion. These systems may place restrictions on the ability of an individual to safely experience the ride

In order to ride, all seatbelts, lap bars, and shoulder harnesses must be positioned and fastened properly. Due to rider restraint system requirements, Guests of a larger size may not be accommodated on some rides.

## KID SWAP:

The Kid Swap program is designed to accommodate groups with younger children who may not be tall enough to ride some attractions. To participate: 1) The entire party should enter the ride queue; 2) When preparing to board, tell the Ride Attendant you are using the Kid Swap program; 3) Children who are not tall enough to ride may wait at the exit with an adult from your party; 4) After the first ride is completed, the adult who waited with the child will be allowed to ride.

## SUPPLEMENTAL RESTRAINT HARNESS (SRH):

The safety of our guests and employees is always our highest priority and we strive to provide a fun, safe experience for all guests. In an effort to better accommodate the needs of guests with certain disabilities Six Flags has worked with ride manufacturers to develop a harness system for select rides in our park which may accommodate those who do not meet the extremity requirement.

In order to utilize the harness you must possess extremities at least 6" in length from each of your shoulder blades and hips. All safety devices must be properly positioned in order to ride. Our Ride Operators will contact their supervisor to verify rider requirements and to assist fitting the SRH and securing you in the ride unit. Seat selection will be dictated when using the SRH. Rides with an SRH will be listed in the Ride Information section if this guide.

## RIDE RATINGS AND WARNINGS:

Ride warning signs can be found at the entrance of each ride to help determine the attractions that are best for Guests based upon their experience level, physical condition and abilities. Information on each ride can also be found on the Park Map and Guide.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### FRIGHT FEST:

Theatrical fog effects, areas of low lighting, loud music, sound effects, and theatrical and strobe lighting are used throughout the park during Fright Fest. This includes streets, midways, outdoor scare zones, mazes and haunted houses both indoor and outdoor, live entertainment venues and children's attractions.

Guests with respiratory sensitivities, history of seizures or epilepsy, or sensitivities to latex, loud music and sound effects are advised not to participate in these attractions. Please adhere to all posted and verbal warnings and directions.

### FAMILY SERVICES/NURSING MOTHERS:

A private room for nursing mothers is available upon request. Baby changing areas and a companion restroom can be found in most restrooms. Please feel free to ask a Team Member for directions to these locations or review a park map.

### HEARING DISABILITIES:

Assisted listening devices are available upon request. Please see Guest Relations for additional information.

American Sign Language Interpreting will be available if requested at least 7 days in advance of your visit. To arrange for sign language interpreting services, please call Guest Relations at 301-249- 1500 ext. 7093160 Monday through Friday 9:00am to 5:00pm.

### VISUAL IMPAIRMENTS:

Guest with Visual Impairments - Guests with Visual Impairments that require assistance from a Personal Care Attendant (PCA) will be provided a complimentary ticket for their PCA, provided the PCA meet the Personal Care Attendant guidelines. (See guidelines for Personal Care Attendant.)

### PREGNANCY:

Guests who know or believe they may be pregnant should follow all rules, guidelines and restrictions listed for each ride. Those who are pregnant should not ride a ride that specifically lists pregnancy as a rider restriction. Please closely review all rules and guidelines at the entrance of each ride.

### FOOD, DRINKS AND COOLERS:

Food, beverages, coolers and grills may not be brought into the park. The only food exceptions are for food allergies as describe below and infant food, in non-glass jars. Six Flags America prohibits the use of grills and open flames in and around the property, including parking lots.

### FOOD ALLERGIES:

Guests who suffer from sensitive or life-threatening allergies may bring food into the park if they do not feel comfortable with the menu options available. In this case, the food must be limited to the individual with the allergy and may contain: two sealable sandwich bags ( 7 inch by 8 inch) and one snack to accommodate their visit( such as a piece of fruit, or a fruit bar, or a snack that fits in a sandwich bag). One small soft sided cooler may be brought into the park to carry these items. No outside beverages are permitted. Please our Guest Relations Office to receive a medical sticker

### FIRST AID:

Emergency Medical Technicians or Paramedics are on duty during all park operating hours. If you require medical assistance, ask any Team Member and they will summon medical personnel to your location. Please refer to your Park Map and Guide for the location of First Aid.

### OXYGEN TANKS/AIR CONCENTRATORS:

Due to the dynamics and certain characteristics of the rides, oxygen tanks or portable systems are not permitted on most of our rides and attractions. Oxygen tanks are permitted in enclosed facilities. For your convenience, the park's First Aid station(s) will be able to appropriately store your additional oxygen tanks during your visit.

## SPECIAL EFFECTS AT THEATERS, RIDES AND ATTRACTIONS:

Theatrical fog and other effects, including but not limited to: haze and other atmospheric effects, scents, areas of low lighting, loud music, sound effects, theatrical lighting and strobe lighting may be used at various locations in the park such as theaters and during Fright Fest. Guests with respiratory sensitivities, history of seizure or epilepsy, or sensitivities to latex, loud music and sound effects are advised not to participate in these attractions. Please adhere to all posted and verbal warnings and directions.

## RIDE INFORMATION

### CAMERAS:

Picture taking and the use of cameras and video recording devices is not permitted on any ride while it is in motion. It is encouraged that Guests leave their equipment with a non-rider or secure it in a locker or their vehicle. Lockers are available to store items for a nominal fee. Guests must have written permission to use photographs and/or recordings of any aspect of the park for commercial broadcasting, advertising, marketing, or publishing in any medium.

### RIDE EVACUATIONS:

If a ride evacuation is necessary, Guests may need to navigate stairs from the highest points of the ride down steeply inclined stairs or walking surfaces. Guests requiring assistance during the ride evacuation may be escorted last in order to expedite the ride evacuation process. Please ask a Ride Attendant about the specific procedures prior to boarding a particular ride.

**Definitions:** Every ride entrance lists height requirements and special instructions regarding the ride. Six Flags uses the following terms:

**Responsible Person (Adult):** In most cases someone who meets all the requirements to ride the ride themselves and is at least 54" tall.

**Accompanied By:** Whenever a Guest needs accompaniment, the accompanying person must meet all the ride requirements and be able to assist the Guest including helping the Guest to board and exit the ride and assisting the Guest down stairs, catwalks, or ladders in case of an evacuation.

**Lap Child:** A lap child is a child who is unable to walk to the ride independently or maintain independent seated postural control.

**Functioning Extremity:** A functioning extremity is a limb over which a person has control. A prosthetic device is not considered a functioning extremity. Six Flags has additional requirements regarding prosthetic devices. Please see the information for each specific ride in the Ride Information section for this Guide. Ability to hold on or brace: Ability to use one's arms to maintain a grasp on an assist bar and support one's body during normal and emergency procedures on a ride and to use one's legs to brace to maintain a seated position during the ride.

**Functioning Arm:** is a full arm with the ability to be flexed at the elbow and a minimum of three full fingers with the ability to hold on with a firm grip.

**Functioning Leg:** is a fully formed natural leg with a foot that has the ability to bend at the knee.

### LOOSE ARTICLE POLICY:

Loose articles such as cell phones, keys, or other small items must be secured in cargo pockets, zippered pockets (or article bins if on the ride dock). All loose articles which cannot be secured must be locked in a locker, or left with a non-rider prior to entering the queue line.



# BATWING

## RIDE DESCRIPTION: High Thrill

An exciting flying roller coaster with high speeds, steep drops, fast turns, inverted loops and sudden stops.

**Height Restriction:** Guests must be at least 54" tall and under 79" tall to ride. Maximum weight per rider is 256 lbs.

**Physical Requirements:** Each rider must maintain an upright seated position with their head against the headrest during the duration of the ride and their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must possess one (1) Functioning Arm and two (2) functioning legs in order to ride. Riders must have control of their leg(s). Riders using a wheelchair must transfer from the wheelchair onto the ride.

**CASTS:** No casts are allowed

**PROSTHETICS:** For your safety and the safety of others, riders must remove medical devices including half or full length orthotics, braces, crutches, canes, prosthetics and any other type of medical assistance device that is not permanently affixed to the rider's body to prevent hazards or loss due to ride forces.

**SUPPLEMENTAL RESTRAINT HARNESS:** Available

**RIDE ACCESS:** Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the Flash Pass entrance and present a valid Attraction Access Pass to a Team Member at the station to receive a wait time.

**LOOSE ARTICLE POLICY:** NO loose articles are permitted. All items must be left in the station, with a non-rider or in a locker.

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# Big Easy Speedway (FEE REQUIRED)

## RIDE DESCRIPTION: High Thrill

A driving ride with high speeds and fast turns.

**Height Restriction:** Passengers must be at least 40" tall. Drivers must be at least 58" tall.

**Physical Requirements:** Each rider must maintain in an upright seated position with their head against the headrest during the duration of the ride and their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. Riders must have two functioning arms and two functioning legs. Drivers must have the ability to hold and turn the steering wheel and depress the foot pedals. Passengers must have the ability to brace themselves. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle.

**CASTS:** No casts are allowed

**PROSTHETICS:** For your safety and the safety of others, riders must remove medical devices including half or full length orthotics, braces, crutches, canes, prosthetics and any other type of medical assistance device that is not permanently affixed to the rider's body to prevent hazards or loss due to ride forces.

**SUPPLEMENTAL RESTRAINT HARNESS:** Available for Passengers ONLY

**RIDE ACCESS:** Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should enter through the Ride Exit and present a valid Attraction Access Pass to a Team Member at the station to receive a wait time.

**LOOSE ARTICLE POLICY:** NO loose articles are permitted. ONLY items secured in a pocket or a fanny pack around a Guest's waist will be deemed acceptable.

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# Bourbon Street Fireball

## RIDE DESCRIPTION: High Thrill

An exciting roller coaster that loops upside down in a circular motion

**Height Restriction:** Guests must be at least 48" tall to ride

**Physical Requirements:** Each rider must maintain in an upright seated position with their head against the headrest during the duration of the ride and their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the ride vehicle at all times. ## GENERAL WATER PARK SAFETY INFORMATION

### SAFE SWIMMING

- Children should always be at arm's reach of a responsible adult.
- It is recommended that both Guests under 48" and weak swimmers wear a lifejacket at all times.
- Lifejackets are available, free of charge. Availability is based on a first come, first serve basis.
- For the safety of all Guests and staff, some attractions have specific height, weight, and health restrictions.
- Personal floatation devices are prohibited; including water wings. Coast Guard approved lifejackets are permitted.
- Please read all safety signage posted at the entrance of all attractions prior to waiting in line and participating.
- Do NOT let children swim unsupervised.
- Persons with hard casts will be prohibited from participating on some attractions.
- The following items are not permitted on any of the attractions: balls, fins, glass masks, mermaid tails, snorkels, and other toys.
- Please do not run, dive or jump into the attractions.
- For your safety, you should be in good health to ride. Only you know your physical conditions or limitations. If you suspect your health could be at risk for any reason, or you could aggravate a pre-existing condition of any kind, **DO NOT RIDE!**

### PARK POLICIES

- Six Flags is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Do not leave personal items unattended.
- Inconsiderate Guests and/or inappropriate behavior from Guests including; line jumping or profanity may result in removal from the park(s) and, without a refund.

- Failure to follow instructions of the Water Park Staff and/or observe safety rules may result in removal from the park(s) and, without a refund.

### GOOD HYGIENE IS IMPORTANT FOR SAFE, CLEAN WATER

- Please shower yourself and your child before entering the water.
- Diaper dependent Guests must wear appropriate waterproof diapers on ALL attractions.
- Please do not drink the pool water.
- Changing diapers on or around the pool decks is not permitted.
- Diaper changing areas are provided in the restrooms, please wash hands with soap and water after changing a diaper.
- Anyone who has experienced a stomach and/or intestinal illness within the past two (2) weeks should not participate in any water related activities.

### FOR YOUR SAFETY AND BENEFIT

- Lifeguard training will occur continuously throughout the day.
- Training drills may involve mannequins and simulated victims.
- Any questions can be directed to a Water Park Supervisor.
- Training drills may occur at any time during operation, and on any of our attractions.
- For your safety, some attractions will observe a safety break that may require Guests to exit the pool for a period of time.

### WEATHER


- There are certain weather circumstances that may cause the entire water park to close earlier or not open at all.
- For your safety, rain, wind or storms may force the water park to cease operation of some, or all of the attractions.
- When it is safe to resume operation, the attractions will re-open.
- Refunds and rainchecks are not offered for inclement weather.

## PROPER AND APPROPRIATE SWIMWEAR IS REQUIRED

- Proper and lined swimsuits are required to be worn to participate on the attractions.
- Swim wear must be appropriate for our family environment.
- Swim wear with buttons, rivets, or sharps are not permitted.
- Shoes of any kind are not permitted on some attractions.
- Loose articles including, but not limited to; hats, sunglasses, phones, keys, and wallets are not permitted on some attractions.
- Please visit our retail shops for all your swim wear needs.

## LOCKERS AND RENTALS

- All day locker rentals are available inside the water park, and based on a first come, first serve basis.
- All lockers are emptied at the end of each night.
- Rental tubes are based on availability and NOT permitted on some attractions.
- Courtesy tubes are available for most attractions.



## **GUEST ACCESSIBILITY INFORMATION**

### **PARKING**

Accessible parking is available on a first-come, first-serve basis within the main parking lot of the Water Park. When you arrive at the parking toll booths, ask a Team Member for instructions regarding where to proceed to the accessible parking lot. Both auto and van accessible spaces are provided. A valid disabled persons parking placard or license plate must be displayed at all times while parked in the designated accessible parking area.

If the designated accessible parking area is full at the time of your arrival, members of your party may be dropped off at the main pick-up/drop-off area, near the main entrance to the park. Please ask a Team Member for directions to additional parking areas.

### **WHEELCHAIRS**

Wheelchairs are available at our Main Street Service Center location. Deposit may be required in addition to rental fee. Guests may also use their own wheelchairs. If you need to take the rented wheelchair outside of the park, a Team Member escort is necessary to do so. Please ask for assistance at our Guest Relations location.

### **GUESTS WITH WHEELCHAIRS OR ECV'S**

Many of our shopping and dining facilities are also wheelchairs accessible. At many of our attractions we have made our queues accessible to Guests using manual wheelchairs.

### **SEGWAY**

Due to varying walkways, terrains and large crowds, we cannot permit the use of two-wheeled, self-balancing electric vehicles such as Segways. Wheelchairs are available for rent, please contact Guest Relations for more information.

## **RESTROOMS**

Most restrooms within the Water Park are accessible for Guests using wheelchairs. Please check the Water Park map for locations. Our park's Team Members or Guest Relations can provide location directions should you need private restroom facilities during your visit.

### **SERVICE ANIMALS**

Trained service animals are welcome at our Six Flags Water Parks. Service animals are limited to dogs and miniature horses that have been individually trained to do work or perform a task for the benefit of an individual with a disability.

Service animals must be house broken and remain on a leash or harness and under the control of its handler at all times. Guests whose service animal demonstrates aggressive and/or annoying actions toward our Guests or Team Member will be directed to remove the animal from the park.

Service animals are welcome in most locations of the Water Park. Our attractions are not equipped or designed for accessibility to service animals. Therefore, a member of your party must be available to stay with the animal while you ride. For your convenience, a Service Animal "Relief Area" is located by Celebration stage in the park. Owners are responsible for disposing of their animal's waste.

### **ATTRACTION ACCESS**

Most of the Water Park's attractions, restaurants and shops are accessible to wheelchairs. Most, if not all attractions require climbing of steps and the transfer to the ride vehicle (tube). Entry, exit and transfer must be accomplished independently by the Guest or with the assistance of a member from their party. Six Flags Team Members are not trained in lifting or carrying persons with disabilities and are therefore not permitted to assist Guests on or off the rides. If in doubt, please contact the Water Safety Staff or Guest Relations for more information.

## HEARING DISABILITIES

Written ride instructions are available at each attraction.

## MEDICAL DEVICES AND MOBILITY AIDES

For your safety and the safety of others, riders may be required to remove medical devices, half or full length orthotics, braces, crutches, canes, prosthetics and any other type of medical assistance device that is not permanently affixed to the rider's body to prevent hazards or loss due to ride forces. These devices may keep the rider from maintaining the proper riding posture, and present a hazard to the rider or others.

If in doubt about your ability to safely experience an attraction, please refer to the *Rider Requirement Sign* at the attraction entrance. You may also consult with the Water Safety Staff for more information. Please also refer to the *Attraction Information* section of this Guide for specific information regarding removal of medical devices and mobility aides on an attraction by attraction basis. If you have any questions, please ask the Water Safety Staff.

## PROSTHETIC DEVICES

Prosthetics are permitted on most attractions in the Water Park, please refer to the *Rider Requirement Sign* at the attraction entrance for specific requirements.

- Riders must be able to safely enter and exit the attraction.
- Riders must be able to maintain the proper riding position throughout the entirety of the attraction.
- The prosthetic must not pose a danger to the patron themselves, others in the attraction, the ride vehicle (tube) and/or the attraction surface (which is for the safety of the Guests to maintain a safe riding surface).
- Guests wearing prosthetic devices must cover any exposed metal with a padded material.

## FIRST AID

Emergency Medical Technicians or Paramedics are on duty during all Water Park operating hours. If you require medical assistance, ask any Team Member and they will summon medical personnel to your location. First Aid is located near Hurricane Bay.

## OXYGEN TANKS/AIR CONCENTRATORS

Due to the dynamics and certain characteristics of the rides, oxygen tanks or portable systems are not permitted on the attractions. Oxygen tanks are permitted in enclosed facilities. For your convenience, the Water Park's First Aid station will be able to appropriately store your additional oxygen tanks during your visit.

## FAMILY SERVICES/NURSING MOTHERS

A private room for nursing mothers is available at First Aid. Baby changing areas and a companion restroom can be found in most restrooms. Please feel free to ask a Team Member for directions to these locations.

## RESTAURANTS

The park's restaurants offer a variety of food options. Assistance is available upon request. Exceptions are made for Guests with special dietary needs including food allergies and baby food/formula. Guests should contact Park Security or Guest Relations upon arrival at the park for approval to bring in special dietary foods. The special dietary food containers will be marked and dated to clearly show that they have been approved for entry into the park.

## PERSONAL CARE ATTENDANT

The Personal Care Attendant (PCA) program is designed to accommodate Guests with disabilities who are in need of support services such as personal hygiene, eating, toileting, transferring, safe movement, maintaining continence and/or medication management, in order to participate in the Water Park's goods, services, and attractions. The PCA's attendance is required to enable the Guest to participate in the Water Park's goods, services, and attractions. The PCA is not a Guest and shall not participate in any of the Water Park's goods, services, or attractions separate and apart from their client. The PCA

receives compensation for the PCA's services, and the PCA is professionally licensed as a home health aide.

If the Water Park discovers that the Guest or the PCA has misrepresented the purpose of the PCA or that the PCA has acted as a patron of the Water Park as opposed to a PCA, the PCA and the Guest will be expelled from the Water Park and may be barred from future entry.

## ATTRACTION INFORMATION

### INTRODUCTION

In general, all riders should be in good health and free from any conditions known or unknown that might be aggravated by riding. To ride, Guests must have the ability to brace themselves upright in the provided ride vehicle (tube) and support their head and neck during the slide/water movements.

### RIDE RATINGS AND WARNINGS

Attraction warning signs can be found at the entrance of each attraction to help determine the attractions that are best for Guests based upon their experience level, physical condition and abilities.

There are inherent risks in the participation in or on any amusement ride or attraction. Patrons have a duty to exercise good judgment and act in a responsible manner while participating on the ride or attraction and to obey all oral and/or written warnings. Patrons also have a duty to properly use all ride and attraction safety equipment provided.

### SPECIAL ACCESS ENTRANCES

Due to the unique nature of Water Park slides and the exits of the slides typically ending into a catch pool or run-out, we are unable to offer any special entrance or access points to our attractions. All pools (Wave Pool, Lazy River, and Activity Pools) have an entrance and exit with a zero-depth entry to allow for wheelchair access.

### LOOSE ARTICLES

For the safety of all Guests and our Team Members, loose articles including; phones, keys, wallets, hats, camera, glasses without a head strap, etc. are not permitted while on the attraction. It is recommended that all personal belongs are stored in a locker or left with a non-rider. The Water Safety Staff cannot be responsible for these items.

### CAMERAS

To ensure the safety of our Guests, picture taking and the use of cameras and video recording devices are not permitted on any attraction, while it is in

motion. It is encouraged that Guests leave their equipment with a non-rider or secure it in a locker or their vehicle. Guests must have written permission to use photographs and/or videotape of Six Flags images for commercial broadcasting, advertising, marketing, or publishing in any medium.

## LARGER FRAMED GUESTS

Many attractions are designed by the manufacturer to accommodate people of average physical stature and body proportion. The design of the attraction may place restrictions on the ability of an individual to safely experience the attraction. Guests of a larger size may not be accommodated on some attractions.

## PREGNANCY

Guests who know or believe they may be pregnant should follow all rules, guidelines and restrictions listed for each attraction. Those who are pregnant should not ride an attraction that specifically lists pregnancy as a rider restriction. Please closely review all rules and guidelines at the entrance of each ride.

## RIDE EVACUATIONS

Attraction evacuations may be necessary due to mechanical/electrical problems, severe weather conditions or interruption of power. If an attraction evacuation is necessary, Guests may need to negotiate stairs from the highest points of the attraction down steeply inclined stairs or walking surfaces. Guests requiring assistance during the attraction evacuation may be escorted last in order to expedite the attraction evacuation process. Please ask the Water Safety Staff about the specific procedures prior to boarding a particular attraction.

## DEFINITIONS

Every attraction entrance lists height requirements, weight restrictions, and special instructions regarding the attraction.

Six Flags uses the following terms:

**Responsible Person (Adult):** A responsible person is someone who meets all the requirements to ride the ride themselves and is at least 54 inches tall or taller.

**Accompanied By:** Whenever a Guest needs accompaniment, the accompanying person must meet all the attraction requirements and be able to assist the Guest including helping the Guest to board and exit the attraction and assisting the Guest down stairs, in case of an evacuation.

**Ability to Hold On or Brace:** Ability to use one's arms to maintain a required posture and/or support one's body during normal and emergency procedures on a ride and to use one's legs to brace to maintain the required position during the ride.



## GENERAL ATTRACTION RULES

- All riders must meet the height requirement.
- All attractions have a minimum and/or maximum weight restrictions.
- Courtesy tubes are provided for all attractions.
- Rental tubes are permitted on some attractions.
- Lap riders are not permitted on any attraction.
- Riders are arranged to balance weight in the tubes, please do not change seating positions.
- Riders must be able to maintain the proper riding position throughout the entire ride.
- Weak swimmers are encouraged to wear a lifejacket.
- Supervision of children by a parent or guardian is required at all times.
- Eyeglasses should be secured with a head strap.
- Footwear of any kind is not permitted on some attractions.
- Casts of any kind are not permitted.
- Secure all loose articles prior to riding in a locker or left in the care of a non-rider while riding.
- Six Flags will not be responsible for the care, loss, or damage of any personal items.
- Proper swimwear is required to participate on the ride.
- Smoking, eating, drinking, chewing gum, horseplay, running, or jumping is not permitted while in line or on the attraction.
- The following are NOT allowed in, near, or around the pools:
  - Snorkels, fins, balls, and tubes of any kind, surface diving, underwater swimming, breathe holding, horseplay, running, or jumping.
- Line jumping for any reason is cause for ejection from the park.
- Do not drink the pool water. Children should be told not to drink the pool water.
- Anyone who has experienced a stomach and/or intestinal illness within the past two weeks may not participate in any water attractions.
- Diaper dependent persons must wear approved waterproof diapers in any water attractions.
- Obey the instructions of the Water Safety Staff at all times. Failure to follow rules and instructions may result in injury to yourself and others.

# Bahama Blast

## RIDE DESCRIPTION: Moderate

A large serpentine flume where multiple persons ride in a raft down a river-rafts-like slide. Guests will experience high speeds, turns, and side-to-side motions. This ride ends in a landing pool 3' deep.

**Height Restriction:** Rider must be at least 48" tall to ride. Riders between 42"-48" must be accompanied by an Adult. Combined weight of riders may not exceed 800 lbs. No single riders.

**Physical Requirements:** Each rider must maintain an upright seated position during the duration of the ride and their arms, hands, legs, and feet inside the tube at all times. In addition, riders must have two (2) functioning arm and two (2) functioning legs.

**CASTS:** Casts are not permitted

**PROSTHETICS:** Prosthetics are not permitted

**RIDE ACCESS:** There is one entrance to this attraction through a queue line and up multiple flights of stairs. Guests must be able to have the physical and cognitive abilities to hold themselves in an upright seated position within the vehicle throughout the course of the ride.

**LOOSE ARTICLE POLICY:** NO loose articles are permitted.

**Physical Requirements:** Each rider must keep their back on the slide, facing forward, crossing your ankles and crossing your arms over your chest. In addition, riders must have two (2) functioning arm and two (2) functioning legs.

**CASTS:** Casts are not permitted

**PROSTHETICS:** Prosthetics are not permitted

**RIDE ACCESS:** Access is through a queue line and up the stairs. There is only one entrance to the ride.

**LOOSE ARTICLE POLICY:** NO loose articles are permitted.

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# Half Pipe

## RIDE DESCRIPTION: Moderate

Riders slide on a tube or raft on a half-pipe type water flume where they travel down a steep wall and ride up the opposite wall oscillating back and forth until they lose momentum sliding into a landing pool 6” deep. Riders will experience steep drops, variable and high speeds, free-falling sensations and multi-directional forces.

**Height Restriction:** Guests must be at least 48” to ride alone. Weight limit is 250lbs for single riders and a maximum combined weight of 600lbs for double riders.

**Physical Requirements:** Guests must be able to have the physical and cognitive abilities to hold themselves in an upright-seated position within the vehicle throughout the course of the ride. In addition, riders must have two (2) functioning arm and two (2) functioning legs. Riders must step up and down into the ride vehicle and will need to transfer from a wheelchair to the ride vehicle.

**CASTS:** Casts are not permitted

**PROSTHETICS:** Prosthetics are not permitted

**RIDE ACCESS:** There is one entrance to this attraction through a queue line and up multiple flights of stairs.

**LOOSE ARTICLE POLICY:** NO loose articles are permitted.

**PROSTHETICS:** Prosthetics are allowed

**RIDE ACCESS:** Access to the Hurricane Bay is through the regular zero depth entry (the shallow end). If necessary, a Guest may enter the water with a wheelchair, in order to unload him or herself with more ease.

**LOOSE ARTICLE POLICY:** NO loose articles are permitted.

**CASTS:** Casts are not permitted on the slides.

**PROSTHETICS:** Prosthetics are not permitted on the slides.

**RIDE ACCESS:** Guests using a manual or electric wheelchair or an ECV should proceed to the pool chair and ask a life guard for assistance transferring to the chair and in and out of the water.

**LOOSE ARTICLE POLICY:** NO loose articles are permitted.

**CASTS:** Casts are not permitted

**PROSTHETICS:** Prosthetics are not permitted

**RIDE ACCESS:** There is one entrance to this attraction through a queue line and up multiple flights of stairs.

**LOOSE ARTICLE POLICY:** NO loose articles are permitted.
