### ACCESSIBILITY POLICIES

All venues are non-smoking establishments and smoking is prohibited. Stroller parking is located outside the Grand Theater and back of house at the Beaver Brothers Bay Showplace. If you are a guest that is in need of assistance, please notify a team member when entering the venue.

#### Venue Rules

Outdoor venues are subject to weather cancellations if the impending weather is deemed a safety concern for our guests and performers.

#### Weather

Show times are subject to change and are dependent on park hours. Seating for the Grand Theater will be closed right at scheduled show time due to certain elements of the show.

### SHOW POLICIES

Rides will re-open as soon as safe operations can be assured. Due to special effects used during Ignite the Night, the queue at the following attractions will close prior to scheduled park closing: Blast Off, Boomerang, Giant Wheel, Red Hawk, Slingshot, and Viper.

#### Ride Closings

Guests are not permitted to enter any backstage area, including restricted ride perimeters. Crossing a physical barrier into a restricted area may result in serious physical injury or death. You should report lost articles to a team member or at Lost & Found.

#### Restricted Areas

IMMEDIATE EVICTION from the park. In any ride queue or on any rides, Six Flags Darien Lake is not responsible for items left in an unsecured area. PHONES ARE NOT ALLOWED OUT WHILE ON ANY RIDE. Violation can result in attractions and should be left with a non-rider or secured in a locker. Selfie sticks are not permitted in general. Loose articles such as keys, cell phones, cameras, and backpacks are not permitted on our rides. ## GUEST SERVICES

#### Lockers

Day use locker rentals are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Locker locations are designated on the park map.

#### Wagon & Wheelchair Rental

Wagons and wheelchairs are permitted in most areas of the park. Guests may rent wagons and manual wheelchairs at the front gate or general Store on a first-come, first-served basis.

#### Electric Convenience Vehicles (ECV)

ECVs are permitted in most areas of the park, and are available to rent at the front gate or general Store on a first-come, first-served basis. Operators must remain aware of and yield to all pedestrians. Six Flags Darien Lake reserves the right to refuse entry of any ECV deemed unsafe for operation due to size, mechanical condition, or functionality. All ECVs must have at least (3) wheels, be battery powered, and be operated by a single operator in a seated position.

#### First Aid

First Aid locations are designated on the park map, and staffed by emergency medical technicians. If you need medical assistance, contact any team member. First Aid is not able to dispense medications, however some basic over-the-counter medications are available for purchase at the First Aid locations or at the General Store near the campground. All injuries must be reported to first aid prior to leaving the park.

#### Lost & Found

If you lose an item, stop by Lost & Found, located at the main gate, to complete an item description. Please note: Six Flags Darien Lake is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

#### Separated Parties

We encourage you to determine a meeting spot and to mark it on the park map when you arrive. We encourage you to have your children visit the Measuring Station at Guest Relations to receive a wristband that includes an area to write your cell phone number. Park paging is not available.

Team members are available to assist you if you are separated from your child. We encourage you to instruct your child to ask any team member for help if they are lost.

#### Measuring Station

Guests may be measured in Guest Relations and receive a height wristband good for that day's visit. Wristbands feature an area to write a cell phone number in case of separation.

#### Parent Swap

The parent swap program allows parents with young children to take turns riding high thrill rides, while another member of your party waits with your child. Please contact a ride's team member to use this program.

### RIDE POLICIES

#### Rider Responsibility & Restrictions

There are inherent risks in the participation of any amusement or water ride. Guests must exercise good judgment and act in a responsible manner while participating in any Six Flags Darien Lake attraction. Guests must also obey all oral and written warnings and properly use all ride safety equipment provided. Guests are encouraged to observe the motion of the ride before deciding to participate. IF IN DOUBT, DO NOT RIDE.

All guests, regardless of ability, must meet the minimum requirements and observe all restrictions posted at the attraction to participate.

#### Re-Ride Policy

Due to the dynamic physical forces experienced while riding, guests are asked to exit after each ride at many of our attractions to allow each guest a brief break. Guests wishing to ride again should utilize the main ride entrance.

## SIX FLAGS CODE OF CONDUCT

To ensure all guests have a fun, safe and memorable experience, please follow all Park Rules. Guests who break Park Rules may be asked to leave the Park without a refund. Thanks for doing your part to ensure that everyone has a great time while visiting!

#### Park Rules

**Good Behavior:** Guests are here to have a good time and are expected to behave in an appropriate family-friendly manner. Unruly, disruptive or offensive behavior, including line-jumping/holding places in line, use of profanity, abusive language or gestures will not be tolerated.

**Dress Code:** In keeping with our family-friendly environment, and for safety reasons, Six Flags enforces a dress code. Proper attire must be worn in the Park at all times, including shirts and appropriate footwear. Clothing or Tattoos with offensive language or graphics are not permitted at any time. Examples of clothing not permitted are those displaying: Profanity, Pornography, Graphic violence, Support of drugs and drug use, Gang symbols and the Promotion of discrimination against any group. Bathing suits may be worn only in waterpark areas. Park admission may be denied if clothing or tattoos are deemed to be inappropriate by management and the Guest refuses all reasonable options. Shirts cannot be turned inside out as a solution.

**No Smoking:** Smoking, including electronic cigarettes (e-cigarettes), is permitted only in areas identified as Designated Smoking Areas.

**Restrictions:** Outside food, beverages, alcoholic beverages, coolers and pets (other than service animals) are not allowed. All guests enter through metal detection and inspection areas. Items that are not permitted in the Park must be returned to your vehicle. No loose articles such as cameras and cell phones are allowed on rides. Guests are not permitted in restricted areas, which include ride and backstage areas.

**Park Re-Entry:** Guests who wish to return to the park on the same day require hand stamps for re-entry.

**Photography:** By entering the Park, guests grant Six Flags the right to film, video, record and photograph guest on Park property and use such footage or photography for any reason without payment or consideration.

**Purchase of Alcohol:** A state-issued ID is required for all alcohol purchases. Only one drink per person will be sold at a time. Alcoholic drinks must remain in designated areas.

**Selfie Sticks, Monopods & Similar Devices:** Selfie sticks, monopods and similar devices are not allowed inside Six Flags parks. Guests who bring selfie sticks to the park will be asked to store them in their cars during their visit.

#### Ride Policies

**Rider Responsibility:** Guests must exercise good judgment and act in a responsible manner while riding. Guests must also obey all oral and written warnings and properly use all ride safety equipment provided. Please refer to specific guidelines posted at the entrance of every ride.

**Safety & Accessibility Guide:** Our goal is to safely accommodate the needs of all guests, including individuals with disabilities. A list of ride-specific restrictions can be found in the Safety and Accessibility Guide available at Guest Relations or on the ride safety signage located at each ride or attraction.

**Ride Restrictions:** Safety is our number one priority. Guests with certain height, weight and/or body proportions may not be able to participate on certain rides if the safety restraints will not operate as designed. Specific ride information is available at the ride and at Guest Relations. Test seats are available at the entrance of certain rides.

**Hurricane Harbor:** Lifejackets must be Coast Guard approved and are available free of charge in various locations throughout Hurricane Harbor. Lifejackets are recommended for weak swimmers and guests under 48". Six Flags recommends that parents supervise children and others with disabilities at all times while in Hurricane Harbor. Children under 48" or others that cannot swim must be within arm's reach of parent/guardian when in the water.

**Line Jumping:** Line jumping is strictly prohibited. Guests are not permitted to save places in line for other guests, or exit the line and return to the previous position, for any reason.

**Kid Swap Program:** We offer a program designed to accommodate groups with younger children who may not be tall enough to ride some rides or attractions. If interested, please follow these steps: 1) Your entire party should enter the queue; 2) When preparing to board, tell the Ride Attendant you are using the Kid Swap Program; 3) Children who are not tall enough to ride may wait at the exit with an adult from your party; 4) After the first ride is completed, the adult who waited with the child will be allowed to ride.

**Loose Articles:** Loose articles are not permitted on most rides and should be left with non-riders or secured in lockers. Six Flags and its employees are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Fanny packs must not interfere with ride restraint systems and are not permitted on certain rides.

**Lost Articles:** Items lost in ride areas should be reported to the ride operator and Lost & Found.

**Inclement Weather:** Rides may be temporarily closed during electrical storms, heavy rain, or high winds. Rides will re-open as soon as safe operations can be assured. The inclement weather policy is posted at Guest Relations and available online at [sixflags.com/darienlake](#).

**First Aid:** A first aid facility is maintained for medical needs. All injuries must be reported to first aid prior to leaving the park.

**Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAVs):** To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all guests, Six Flags Darien Lake prohibits the operation or use of any unmanned aerial vehicle on, from, or above Six Flags Darien Lake's premises absent specific written consent. This includes all UAVs also commonly known as "drones", regardless of their size, weight or purpose.
