

Step outside the classroom and tour our 350 acre safari with over 1,200 animals, 70 different species from six continents. A tour guide will be with you from start to finish. This program corresponds with NJ State Learning Standards and lesson plans were develop by a NJ State Certified teacher on our staff. The theme park is closed to focus on this program. Available select dates in April and May.

- Define HUSBANDRY and 2 ways that Six Flags cares for the animals that live there
- Identify 3 pollutants and how they negatively affect the environment
- Identify 3 ways humans can positively impact the environment
- Define ecosystem and give 2 reasons why a healthy ecosystem is important
- Recall the geographical regions by certain species that live there
- Define CAMOUFLAGE and give an example of how an animals camouflages into its environment
- Demonstrate coordination, interpersonal, and intrapersonal skills while touching or feeding animals and/or artifacts and practicing good sanitary techniques SWBAT identify the geographical habitats and food sources of California sea lions.
- Compare and contrast marine and land mammals
- In their own words explain how we train/communicate with our animals at Six Flags
- Describe RELATIONSHIP and why it's important when working with animals
- Apply the knowledge of zoo animal care to their own pets at home
- SWBAT explain why some animals live in large groups/herds
- SWBAT explain the difference between antlers and horns
- SWBAT to identify certain animals by different artifacts such as fur, feathers, skulls etc.

 - **Camp Aventura** – mid way through tour. Smaller exotic animals, giraffe feed, gift shop, lunch.

5 easy steps to book your program!

Select dates in April and May when the theme park is closed!

A confirmation email will be sent after each step!

Step 1: Confirm date availability by calling 732-928-2000 ext. 2221 or emailing safariprograms@sixflags.com

Step 2: Fill out and send in the attached **Reservation Form** ASAP to reserve the date

Step 3: Fill out and send in the attached **Order Form** at least 2 weeks prior to the event

Step 4: Send in **Truck Assignment Sheets** at least one week prior to the event.

Step 5: Receive wristbands and parking vouchers for any personal cars in the mail.

Preparing for your trip

Physical Conditions:

There is a considerable amount of walking through the theme park to get to the different locations as well as at Camp Aventura. Please instruct all to wear comfortable shoes.

Weather:

This program is 100% outside and takes place rain or shine. Please dress according to the weather. The trucks are open air and do get breezy. In the event there is severe weather (thunderstorms or downpours), you will be offered another day to reschedule.

Wheelchairs:

We are ADA accessible. Please let safari staff know about anyone in a wheelchair. We do have wheelchairs to transfer in to at our Camp Aventura location if needed.

Lunches:

You are permitted to bring your lunches and are given time to eat them during the program. The students can carry their lunches throughout the program, **OR** you can have all the lunches in large bags or coolers. Safari staff will collect them and bring them to the lunch locations. We recommend you divide lunches up based on your **Truck Assignment Worksheets** and not necessarily by class. Please make sure all lunches and containers are labeled.

Gift Shop:

There is a gift shop at our Camp Aventura location. We have seen that the gift shop takes up a large portion of time and may result in missing parts of the safari to accommodate your departure time. Please help any students that would like to buy something to keep it efficient.

Bus Drivers:

The theme park is closed. Bus Drivers are permitted to leave and come back. Please have their phone numbers so they can be called in the event the program ends early. Please include them in your count if they are participating in the program.

Getting here/parking: Please use our Employee and Service Entrance (¼ mile on the left past the main theme park entrance). Please stay in the right lane to check in with the security guard. A safari staff member will escort you to the parking area. **WE DISCOURAGE PERSONAL CARS. PLEASE LET SAFARI STAFF KNOW OF ANY PERSONAL CARS ATTENDING. AN ADDITIONAL FEE WILL APPLY PER CAR.**
