



Performance Guidelines & Information

Here are some helpful hints to make your performance and your day at Six Flags an adventure you won't forget!

BEFORE YOUR TRIP

- **IMPORTANT: Six Flags is a family destination.** Please make sure your group's costume, music and performance are appropriate for Guests of all ages.
 - If you have any questions, please ask in advance of the performance day.
 - Six Flags reserves the right to cancel performances not in keeping with our family friendly guidelines.
- Majestic Theater is an indoor venue; stage dimensions are available below but can change without notice due to the addition or removal of stage set pieces.
- Large Props are discouraged. Performers must be able to carry props through the turnstiles at the front gate.
- IMPORTANT: Neatly write or type an introduction for your group on a separate piece of paper; introduction must be 50 words or less.

CHECK-IN

- Majestic Theater doors open 15 minutes after park opening (consult online calendar for exact park hours).
- A Medical Release/Liability form must be submitted for each participant on your performance day.
 Anyone without a Medical Release form will not be permitted to perform.
- For check-in, please have your participants arrive with their own medical release forms. Medical Release forms can be checked in both individually or as a group.
- Please arrive in costume. Dressing rooms <u>are not</u> available at the stage area. Restroom facilities are near Johnny Rockets and The Gunslinger for changing after your performance.
- Dancers should be dressed and ready to perform 30 minutes prior to their scheduled performance time. This is imperative as performances do sometimes run ahead of schedule.

PERFORMANCE INFO

- Six Flags is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. Rental lockers are available inside the park. Bags will not be permitted on stage.
- Dancers will be queued on benches in house right, and will exit stage after performance in house left.
- Each dance studio will be allowed 15 minutes maximum time (with a max of 5 routines at 3 minutes each.)
 Individual groups are allowed 4 minutes per performance. Six Flags reserves the right to dim the music and lights if time exceeds the allotted limit.
- No costume changes or shoe changes will be permitted during your performance time.
- Six Flags is not equipped to handle acrobatic, gymnastic, or roller blading routines. Please refrain from incorporating them into your performance.
- There is not an available warm-up space so please warm-up before arriving at Six Flags.
- We can accommodate a CD or mp3 player
 - o If you bring your music on a CD, please have a backup CD as well Please provide 1 person who is familiar with the routines to sit in the sound booth with the sound technician. This insures the performers are ready and that the music is being played, paused, and stopped in the correct order.
 - If you use an mp3 player Please provide 1 person from the group to operate the mp3 player from the sound booth and to ensure the music plays correctly. The sound technician will not be responsible for searching for songs or pausing between songs during the performance.

Friends and family are welcome to join the fun. Make sure they order discounted tickets with the group!
